Open - Boxer winning its title with highest average score in one calendar year (if available from CKC record cards) or highest score from first three consecutive trials in one calendar year

Shadowdale's Bounty Hunter CDX, Am. CD NA, FDCH, CGC, TDI, TT; Sharon Campbell

Utility - Boxer winning its title with the highest average score in one calendar year (if available from CKC record cards) or highest score from first three consecutive trials in one calendar year
