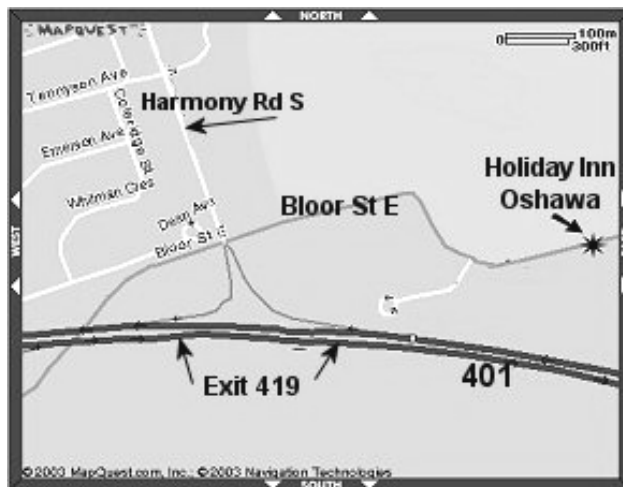

Declined credit cards will be deemed as non payment and entries will not be accepted. Entries processed by credit card and cancelled before closing will have a \$5.00 service charge applied. A communication charge of \$3 will be applied for incomplete entries which require us to contact the exhibitor by phone.

## General Information

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the Show which will be governed by CKC rules. The Boxer Club of Canada Inc. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the Show, no refund of Entry will be made. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging and will be excused when not required for further judging. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called three times, it will be marked absent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ring side when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds (dogs) must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds (dogs) conflict. Judging times will be specified in the judging schedule sent to each exhibitor. If space is at a premium, we may restrict the size and placing of chairs, tables, crates and exercise pens. Private exercise pens must be kept clean.

**SHOW PRECINCTS:** The show precincts shall be inside all the rings and any other areas designated by the Show Superintendent.

### DOG SHOW CLASS INFORMATION:

**JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS:** shall be for dogs at least 6 mos. of age on the first day of the show and under 9 mos. of age.

**SENIOR PUPPY CLASS:** shall be for dogs at least 9 mos. of age on the first day of the show and under 12 mos. of age on the first day of the show.

**12 to 15 MONTHS CLASS:** shall be for dogs at least 12 mos. of age on the first day of the show and under 15 mos. of age on the first day of the show.

**15 to 18 MONTHS CLASS:** shall be for dogs at least 15 mos. of age on the first day of the show and under 18 mos. of age on the first day of the show.

**CANADIAN BRED CLASS:** shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** dogs entered in this class must be owned and bred by the person who handles it in the ring.

**OPEN BRINDLE CLASS:** shall be for all dogs of the brindle colour

**OPEN FAWN CLASS:** shall be for all dogs of the fawn colour.

**VETERANS CLASS:** shall be for dogs 7 years of age and over on the date of the show.

**SPECIALS ONLY CLASSES:** shall be for Champions of record at the time of the closing of entries for the show. (See also moving a class dog to specials and ERN information)

### UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

**EXHIBITION ONLY:** shall be for all dogs. Dogs entered in exhibition only shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. No dog so entered may compete in any regular class but may be entered in and compete in non-regular classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS:** shall be comprised of the Stud Dog and 2 or more of his get. All dogs comprising the get need not be the property of the same exhibitor.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** shall be comprised of the Brood Bitch and 2 of her progeny. All dogs comprising the progeny need not be the property of the same exhibitor.

**BRACE CLASS:** shall be comprised of 2 dogs not necessarily of the same sex, of one breed, the property of the same exhibitor. (Same exhibitor means ownership of both dogs must be identical.)

### DOGS ENTERED IN NON-REGULAR CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

**ERN:** Effective Jan.1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the 1st day of entering a CKC event. **Attention Foreign Exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheque "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as they will not be cleared by banks. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the Entry Form are completed in full. HANDLERS or AGENTS please note the full name and address of all owners MUST BE FILLED IN. Incomplete Entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by Entry Fees. Telephone and Telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or why or by whom the entries were made.

Alterations, Substitutions, or Cancellations of any Entry after the closing date is prohibited, except moving Class Dogs to Specials. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

**ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE AT THE TIME AND DATE SHOWN IN THIS PREMIUM LIST** and must be in the hands of the Show secretary by that time and date. Identification slips and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification slips must be presented upon arrival at the show.

Tendering of NSF Cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF Cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

### Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal Cheques payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry will be accepted. Personally discounted Cheques will not be accepted.

Please do not mark personal Cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your co-operation is appreciated.

### Dog Show Rules

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Dog Show Rules of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Chapter 8 - Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules states. A judge officiating at a show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

### Moving a Class dog to Specials

Chapter 13, Section 13 of the Dog Show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the Show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, not one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

### Champions & Championship Points

Chapter 20, Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS, at a championship Dog Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder., Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing* (includes dog awarded winners)	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards. Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

\*NOTE: There will be a 1 hour break for lunch (to be announced) Exhibitors are responsible for their own lunch
